EVALUATION CRITERIA: Bids will be evaluated using the 80/20 principle of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, 2000 (Act No. 5 of 2000, Preferential Procurement Regulations 2017) and including the BBBEE (Act No. 53 of 2000).

CLOSING DATE: Documents shall be sealed envelope, clearly endorsed with the bid number for the relevant project, and must be placed in the tender box at the Municipal Offices, 25 Bredelia Street, Kwa-Mbonambi, on or before 12h00 on the 21st of February 2018, when they will be opened in public. Bids received after the closing date will not be considered. Facsimile and e-mail tenders will not be considered. The lowest or any other tenders may not necessarily be accepted by the municipality. Registration on the Council's Database is a prerequisite.

Bids shall remain valid for a period of 90 days from the closing date.
