Notice is hereby given in terms of chapter 11 of the Municipal Finance Management Act, (Act no.56 of 2003). The Municipality is hereby inviting suitably qualified service providers to supply and deliver the following licensed vehicles:

**EVALUATION CRITERIA:** Bids will be evaluated using 80/20 principle of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, (Act No.5 of 2017) and including the BBBEE (Act No.53 of 2000).

A non-refundable tender deposit of R 250.00 per tender payable in cash or by a bank guaranteed cheque made out in favour of uMfolozi Municipality is required on collection of the tender documents. *No documents will be sold at the briefing session.* Only Service Providers with valid documents will be allowed at the briefing session.

**CLOSING DATE:** Tenders are to be submitted in a sealed envelope, clearly marked with the relevant tender description and tender number, and must be placed in the tender box at the Municipal Offices, 25 Bredelia Street, Kwa-Mbonambi, on or before 12h00 on the 31<sup>st</sup> of March 2017, when they will be opened in public. Bids received after the closing date will not be considered. Facsimile and e-mail tenders will not be considered. The lowest or any other tenders may not necessarily be accepted by the municipality.

Bids shall remain valid for a period of 90 days from the closing date.
