EVALUATION CRITERIA: Bids will be evaluated using the 80/20 principle of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, 2000 (Act No.5 of 2000) and including the BBBEE (Act No. 53 of 2000).

CLOSING DATE: Tenders are to be submitted in a sealed envelope, clearly marked with the relevant tender description and tender number, and must be placed in the tender box at the Municipal Offices, 25 Bredelia Street, Kwa-Mbonambi, on or before 12h00 on the 24th of March 2017 when they will be opened in public. Bids received after the closing date will not be considered. Facsimile and e-mail tenders will not be considered. The lowest or any other tenders may not necessarily be accepted by the municipality.

Bids shall remain valid for a period of 90 days from the closing date.
