CLOSING DATE: Tenders are to be submitted in a sealed envelope, clearly marked with the relevant tender description and tender number, and must be placed in the tender box at the Municipal Offices, 25 Bredelia Street, Kwa-Mbonambi, on or before 12h00 on the 6th of July 2017 when they will be opened in public. Bids received after the closing date will not be considered. Facsimile and e-mail tenders will not be considered. The lowest or any other tenders may not necessarily be accepted by the municipality.
